EPA’s Lead Safe Renovation, Repair & Painting (RRP) Rules
Effective April 22, 2010

WHO MUST DO THIS? Residential Builders & Commercial General Contractors, Painters, Electrical, Plumbing and HVAC Contractors. It also impacts window, siding, demolition, and historic renovation, and other specialty contractors.

WHAT JOBS DOES IT IMPACT? Any activity that disturbs paint in pre-1978 housing and child-occupied facilities such as schools and daycare facilities. Examples of work include remodeling and repair/maintenance, electrical work, plumbing, painting, carpentry, and window replacement.

Titan Environmental Services will conduct an eight (8) hour EPA approved training class with a 50 question multiple choice test at the end of the class. Upon completion of the class and successful completion of the test, each student will receive their certification. The certification is a five (5) year certification. EPA limits class size to 25 registrants.
